



## INSTRUMENT APPROACH CHART - ICAO

**DIRECT ARRIVAL FROM NORTH VIA N560 (VOR OR NDB(L))**  
**VOR WIK** : At MSA or above, at 10 DME WIK turn right to intercept the 8 DME arc WIK (anticlockwise) descending to **not below 1800(1686)**. At lead radial R321 WIK turn left to intercept the R314 (134°M) inbound WIK VOR, once established on the FAT continue as for the Basic Procedure.  
**NDB(L) WCK** : At MSA or above, at 10 DME WIK turn right to intercept the 8 DME arc WIK (anticlockwise) descending to **not below 1800(1686)**. At lead QDM 140° NDB(L) WCK turn left to intercept the QDM 128° inbound NDB(L) WCK, once established on the FAT continue as for the Basic Procedure.

**DIRECT ARRIVAL FROM SOUTH VIA N560 or Y904 (VOR only)**  
AT MSA or above, at 7 DME WIK turn right to intercept the 5 DME arc WIK (CAT A,B), or at 9 DME WIK turn right to intercept the 7 DME arc (CAT C,D). Once established on the 5 or 7 DME arc:  
**From N560** : Descend **not below 2600(2486)**, when crossing R187 WIK descend **not below 1800(1686)**.  
**From Y904** : descend **not below 1800(1686)**.  
At lead radial R135 WIK turn left to intercept the R119 inbound to WIK VOR, **not below 1800(1686)**. Continue to overhead WIK VOR then follow Basic Procedure.

**DIRECT ARRIVAL FROM NORTHWEST VIA ROUTE YANKEE AND RATSU (VOR OR NDB(L))**  
**VOR WIK** : Intercept the R314 WIK VOR inbound, not below MSA. At R314/10 DME WIK VOR (IAF) descend **not below 1800(1686)** then continue as for Basic Procedure.  
**NDB(L) WCK** : Intercept the QDM 128° WCK inbound, not below MSA. At IAF 128°M/10 DME (IAF) descend **not below 1800(1686)** then continue as for Basic Procedure.
