
Subject Airspace Restrictions



RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: TYNWALD DAY CEREMONY, ST JOHN'S, ISLE OF MAN, 05 JULY 2023

- 1 The Tynwald Day Ceremony will be held at St John's, Isle of Man on **05 July 2023**. The Isle of Man Civil Aviation Administration has deemed it necessary to introduce the Civil Aviation (Restriction of Flying) (Tynwald Day) Regulations 2023 (SD No. 2023/0106) in order to restrict flying in the vicinity of the event.
- **2** Between 0900 and 1200 on 05 July 2023, aircraft must not be flown below 2500 FT AMSL within the area bounded by a circle of radius 2 NM centred on 541213N 0043832W (St Johns, Isle of Man).
- The Restricted Airspace does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with a permission issued by the Isle of Man Civil Aviation Administration or an authorised person.
- 4 The Restricted Airspace also applies to small unmanned aircraft of any MTOM.
