
Subject Airspace Restrictions



RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: WIMBLEDON LAWN TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS 29 JUNE 2024 - 15 JULY 2024

- 1 The 2024 Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Championships will take place between 29 June 2024 and 15 July 2024. There will be a large gathering of people at the event; therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2 The chart in this document relates to the area defined in the associated text; this area will be subject to NOTAM action; this to be read in conjunction with this document.
- 3 The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 4 Subject to paragraph 5, between **0500 hours and 2200 hours** on each day **beginning with 29 June 2024 and ending on 15 July 2024**, no aircraft is to fly below 1500 FT AMSL within the area of a circle having a radius of 0.75 NM whose centre is 512601N 0001250W.
- **5** Paragraph 4 does not apply to any aircraft:
 - a) Operated by or on behalf of;
 - i. The National Police Air Service;
 - ii. The Helicopter Emergency Medical Services;
 - b) making an approach to, or departure from London Heathrow Airport whilst under the control of the London Terminal Control Centre Swanwick, or air traffic control unit at London Heathrow Airport; or
 - c) flying in accordance with the permission of the Championships Safety Officer who may be contacted on telephone 07801-570030, or through the Event Emergency Control Room on telephone 020-8971 2430, or through the Police Emergency Control Room (Silver Control) on telephone 020-8971 2666.
- In relation to this document, the term 'aircraft' includes any small balloon, any kite, any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute or paramotor.
