## **RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: DUXFORD, 05 MAY - 05 OCTOBER 2024**

- 1 The 2024 Duxford Airshows will take place **between 05 May and 05 October 2024**. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2 The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 3 Subject to the dates and times within paragraph 5, between 05 May and 05 October 2024 no aircraft is to fly below 4500 FT AMSL within the area of a circle having a radius of 2.2 NM whose centre is 520527N 0000755E.
- **4** Paragraph 3 does not apply to any aircraft:
  - a) Flying in accordance with the permission of the Flying Display Director at Duxford Aerodrome who may be contacted on telephone number 01223-833376, or with the permission of the Duxford Aerodrome Air Traffic Service who may be contacted on Frequency 122.080 MHz.
  - b) Operated by or on behalf of the:
    - i. The National Police Air Service;
    - ii. The Helicopter Emergency Medical Services.
