

## RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: ABINGDON AIR AND COUNTRY SHOW 17 – 18 MAY 2024

- The 2024 Abingdon Air and Country Show will take place between **17 and 18 May 2024**. There will be a large gathering of people at the event; therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2 The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 3 Subject to paragraph 4, between 1200 and 1400 hours on 17 May 2024 and between 1200 and 1600 hours on 18 May 2024, no aircraft is to fly below 6000 FT AMSL within the area of a circle having a radius of 3 NM whose centre is 514126N 0011859W.
- 4 Paragraph 3 does not apply to any aircraft:
  - a) Operating in accordance with a clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at Royal Air Force Brize Norton;
  - b) Making an approach to or departure from Oxford Airport whilst under the direction of the air traffic control unit at that airport;
  - c) Operated by or on behalf of the:
    - i. The National Police Air Service;
    - ii. The Helicopter Emergency Medical Services; or
  - d) Operating with the permission of the Abingdon Air and Country Show flying display director who may be contacted on telephone 07977-901711 or via email baconga@hotmail.com.
- In relation to this document, the term 'aircraft' includes any small balloon, any kite, any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute or paramotor.
