
RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: SHERBURN-IN-ELMET, YORKSHIRE 18 - 19 MAY 2024

- 1 The Royal Aero Club Sherburn-in-Elmet Air Race will be held at Sherburn-in-Elmet Aerodrome, Yorkshire, between 18 and 19 May 2024. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2 The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 3 Subject to paragraph 4, between 1045 and 1545 hours on 18 May and 1015 and 1515 hours on 19 May 2024, no aircraft is to fly below 1500 FT AMSL within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the following points:

- 4 Paragraph 3 does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with a permission granted by:
 - a) Sherburn-in-Elmet Aerodrome air-ground service; or
 - b) The Royal Aero Club Records, Racing and Rally Association Race Officials; or
 - c) Operated by or on behalf of the:
 - i. The National Police Air Service; or
 - ii. The Helicopter Emergency Medical Services; or
 - iii. Maritime and Coastguard Agency.

- 7 In relation to this document, the term 'aircraft' includes any small balloon, any kite, any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute or paramotor.
