## RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: TYNWALD DAY CEREMONY, ST JOHN'S, ISLE OF MAN, 05 JULY 2024

- 1** The Tynwald Day Ceremony will be held at St John's, Isle of Man on **05 July 2024**. The Isle of Man Civil Aviation Administration has deemed it necessary to introduce the Civil Aviation (Restriction of Flying) (Tynwald Day) Regulations 2024 (SD No. 2024/0083) in order to restrict flying in the vicinity of the event.
- 2** **Between 0900 and 1200 on 05 July 2024**, aircraft must not be flown below 2500 FT AMSL within the area bounded by a circle of radius 2 NM centred on 541213N 0043832W (St Johns, Isle of Man).
- 3** The Restricted Airspace (Temporary) applies to all aircraft, including small unmanned aircraft of any MTOM, except those flying in accordance with a permission issued by the Isle of Man Civil Aviation Administration or an authorised person.
