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Subject Airspace Restrictions



RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: KING'S BIRTHDAY FLYPAST REHEARSALS 03 - 04 JUNE 2024

- A large formation of military aircraft will form His Majesty the King's Birthday Flypast on 15 June 2024; rehearsals for this flypast will be held during the period **03 June 2024 and 04 June 2024**. The rehearsals will start in the vicinity of the North Sea adjacent to East Anglia then route via the overhead of RAF Marham, Norfolk and overfly RAF Cranwell and RAF Waddington Lincolnshire, dispersal will occur over Lincolnshire. Due to the large number of aircraft involved, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation order 2016.
- The charts in this document relate to the areas defined in the associated text; all areas will be subject to NOTAM action; these are to be read in conjunction with this document. Pilots are strongly encouraged to employ the use of moving map technology and/or an air traffic service to mitigate the risk of inadvertent airspace infringements.

Note: Following a successful rehearsal, the subsequent rehearsal day will be cancelled by NOTAM.



 - iv. The ATC unit at Norwich Airport;
 - v. Lincolnshire Terminal Air Traffic Control Centre (TATCC); or,
 - vi. The ATC units at Waddington, Cranwell, Coningsby or Barkston Heath whilst under the direction of Lincolnshire TATCC.
 - b) Operated by or on behalf of the:
 - i. The National Police Air Service;
 - ii. The Helicopter Emergency Medical Services; or,
 - iii. The Maritime and Coastguard Agency
 - c) Operating with the permission of:
 - i. The Royal Air Force Kings Birthday Flypast Project Officer who may be contacted on telephone number 07771-751710;
 - ii. 78 Squadron Swanwick Military, who may be contacted via telephone number 01489-612417 (West Supervisor) or 01489-612408 (East Supervisor).
- These RA(T)s directly affect a number of ATZs and also aerodromes and flying sites that do not have ATZs. Aerodrome Operators and ATS Units affected by the RA(T) are requested to bring this AIC to the attention of their resident and local operators.
- **9** In relation to this document, the term 'aircraft' includes any small balloon, any kite, any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute or paramotor.
