

## RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: BLACKPOOL, LANCASHIRE, 10 - 11 AUGUST 2024

- 1 The Blackpool Seafront Air Display will take place **between 10 and 11 August 2024.** A large number of aircraft will be engaged in high-energy manoeuvres; therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2 Subject to paragraph 4, between 1200 and 1630 hours daily on 10 and 11 August 2024, no aircraft is to fly below 5000 FT AMSL within the area of a circle having a radius of 2 NM whose centre is 534856N 0030325W.
- 3 The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 4 Paragraph 3 does not apply to any aircraft flying:
  - a) with the permission of the Blackpool Seafront Airshow flying display director who may be contacted on telephone number 07731-477156 or via email roddean79@gmail.com;
  - b) with a clearance issued by the Air Traffic Control Unit at Blackpool Airport; or
  - c) operated by or on behalf of:
    - i. The National Police Air Service; or
    - ii. The Helicopter Emergency Medical Services; or
    - iii. The Maritime and Coastguard Agency.
- Pilots operating into and out of Blackpool Airport are to be fully aware of the extent of the Restricted Area (Temporary) (RA(T)) which extends to within 0.65 NM of Runway 10/28. By remaining south of the A5230 (Squires Gate Lane), pilots will remain outside of the RA(T).
- In relation to this document, the term 'aircraft' includes any small balloon, any kite, any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute or paramotor.
