
**Subject** Airspace Restrictions



## RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: THE OPEN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS, ROYAL TROON, AYRSHIRE, 14 – 22 JULY 2024

- 1 The 2024 Open Golf Championships will be held **between 14 and 22 July 2024** at Royal Troon Golf Course, Troon, Ayrshire. A large number of spectators will attend the event; therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided it is necessary to introduce Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2 The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 3 Subject to paragraph 4, between 0500 hours and 2230 hours daily between the 14 and 22 July 2024, no aircraft is to fly below 4000 FT AMSL within the area of a circle having a radius of 1.5 NM whose centre is at 553133N 0043830W.
- 4 Paragraph 3 does not apply to any aircraft:
  - a) Operated by or on behalf of:
    - i. The Scottish Air Ambulance;
    - ii. Police Scotland; or,
    - iii. The Maritime and Coastquard Agency, whilst conducting Search and Rescue operations.
  - b) Making an approach to, or departing from, Glasgow Prestwick Airport whilst under the control of the air traffic control unit at Glasgow Prestwick Airport; or,
  - c) Flying in accordance with the permission of the Police Aviation Safety and Security Unit who may be contacted on telephone numbers 01786-895840 or 07765-749919 (Urgent Only) or via email: OSDAviationEvents@scotland.police.uk.
- In relation to this document, the term 'aircraft' includes any small balloon, any kite, any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute or paramotor.
