INFORMATION FOR PILOTS OPERATING TO/FROM GOODWOOD AERODROME, 12 MARCH - 28 APRIL 2024

1 General

- 1.1 This Circular provides information to pilots operating to/from Goodwood Aerodrome **12 March–28 April 2024**. This period includes the build and breakdown of an event site, and a motor racing event.
- 1.2 Goodwood Aerodrome to remain open throughout the period of this AIC. Published operational hours apply unless changed by NOTAM.
- 1.3 Except for flights during the event, pilots to PPR by telephone by contacting ATS on 01243-755061.
- 1.4 Goodwood Information is 122.455 MHz.
- 1.5 The information included in this circular is subject to change and pilots should always consult the latest NOTAMs for the most accurate information.

2 The Event Site

- 2.1 The event site includes the eastern portion of Goodwood Aerodrome, the Motor Circuit and additional land to the east of the aerodrome. The event site lies within an irregularly shaped four-sided area bounded by co-ordinates at 505156N 0004615W, 505117N 0004545W, 505112N 0004505W and 505145N 0004433W.
- 2.2 The eastern portion of Goodwood Aerodrome apportioned to the event site incrementally. Runways 10/28 and 06/24 handed over as 3.4 and 3.5 below.

3 General Restrictions

- 3.1 Flying before and after the event may be restricted by the construction and dismantling of grandstands, marquees, fairground rides and other structures. A large temporary aircraft hangar, restricting visibility from the ATS Unit of aircraft on the southernmost part of Runway 14/32, results in redeclared distances on that runway.
- 3.2 Multiple cranes across the event site active during both the build and breakdown phases. Date, times, position and elevation of each crane notified by NOTAM.
- 3.3 RWY 14/32 redeclared distances 15 March–28 April 2024.
- 3.4 RWY 10/28 closed **25 March-28 April 2024**.
- 3.5 RWY 06/24 closed **11–16 April 2024**.
- 3.6 Flying outside published operational hours prohibited 07-17 April 2024.

4.1 Building of the event 12 March-12 April 2024.

5 The Motor Racing Event

- 5.1 The 81st Members Meeting annual motor racing event Sat/Sun 13-14 April 2024.
- 5.2 Operational hours 0730-1800 (0630-1700).Only helicopters are permitted during this event.

- 5.4 Pilots in flight to provide their PPR number, if requested by ATS.
- 5.5 There is no marshalling/handling service, and pilots are responsible for parking and passenger safety.
- 5.6 Pilots to make their approach or departure to/from the intersection of Runways 06/24 and 14/32 (505136N 0004536W).
- 5.7 Flights over the motor racing circuit not below 500 FT AGL or 620 FT AMSL. Flights over grandstands and the eastern end of Runways 06/24 and 10/28 to be avoided.
- 5.8 Inbound pilots to report at the Trundle (505334N 0004514W) from the north, the Solar Panels (505145N 0004733W) from the west or Point Sierra from the south-east (505110N 0004344W).
- 5.9 Outbound pilots to route via the same reporting points. Traffic information provided when necessary.
- 5.10 Approaches/departures to/from other directions to be avoided.
