ISLE OF MAN AIRPORT (EGNS) - TAXIWAY REDESIGNATION

1 Introduction

Isle of Man Airport is redesignating several taxiways to provide a compliant taxiway designation convention:

- a) Redesignate the southern portion of taxiways Charlie and Foxtrot to form part of Taxiway Delta.
- b) Redesignate Taxiway Alpha, West of Runway 21, to Taxiway Lima.
- c) Redesignate the holding points on the northern portion of taxiways Charlie and Foxtrot.
- d) Introduce two new holding points: L3 and F3.

2 Programme

All civil works and electrical enabling works will be completed in advance of the transition phases. The redesignation will then take place in four phases:

a) Phase 1

Install and wrap to obscure signs at new holding points L3 and F3. On Romeo, remove points Q & P and install new reflective signs at R1. No impact on Airfield Operations.

b) Phase 2

Taxiways Delta, Charlie South and Foxtrot South taken out of service and lit barriers placed. New signs fitted and obscured. Operations in Area Whisky will be maintained via holding point D1. Temporary taxiway closures will be promulgated by NOTAM.

c) Phase 3

Holding points CX and FX taken out of service. Signage replacement to be done out of operational hours. Closure and removal of CX and FX will be promulgated by NOTAM.

d) Phase 4

Rest of the airfield signage converted to the new designation and the AGL control system updated out of operational hours the evening before go-live.

The original programme had a projected go-live date of **21 March 2024**, which due to unforeseen circumstances has been deferred until **28 November 2024**.

3 Promulgation

The UK AIP entry for EGNS shows the new designation as of AIRAC 03/2024 (effective **21 March 2024**). These will be reverted to the old Taxiway designation in AIRAC 04/2024.

Airlines are encouraged to confirm with their aerodrome information and chart suppliers that the taxiway redesignation has a revised go live date of **28 November 2024**.
