RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: DUXFORD 10 MAY – 22 JUNE 2025			

- The first yearly airshows at Duxford Aerodrome will take place between 10 May 2025 and 22 June 2025. A large number of aircraft will be
 involved in high-energy manoeuvres therefore, the Secretary of State for Transport has decided that it is necessary to introduce Restriction of
 Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.
- 2. The times mentioned in this Notice are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).
- 3. Subject to paragraph 4 on the dates and times within paragraph 5, **between 10 May 2025 and 22 June 2025** no aircraft is to fly below 4500 FT AMSL within the area of a circle having a radius of 2.2 NM whose centre is 520527N 0000755E.
- 4. Paragraph 3 does not apply to any aircraft:
 - a. operated by or on behalf of:
 - i. a Police Air Support Unit,
 - ii. an Emergency Medical Service, or
 - b. flying with the permission of the flying display director at Duxford Aerodrome who may be contacted via telephone number 07787-567016, or via the Duxford Aerodrome Flight Information Service (AFIS) on Channel 122.080.
- 5. The restrictions defined in paragraphs 3 and 4 are established on the dates in column 1 between the times listed in column 2:
