## TEMPORARY RESERVED AREA (TEESSIDE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT): PRIME AIR BVLOS TRIAL 18 DECEMBER 2025 - 18 JUNE 2026

- 1 Beyond Visual Line of Sight (BVLOS) operations will take place **between 18 December 2025 and 18 June 2026**. The Prime Air Uncrewed Aircraft System (UAS) will be operating Beyond Visual Line of Sight and does not yet have an approved Detect and Avoid capability, therefore will be segregated in this phase of the trial within a Temporary Reserved Area (TRA) and Transponder Mandatory Zone (TMZ).
- 2 The TRA/TMZ is sponsored by Prime Air in accordance with Airspace Change Proposal ACP-2024-056.
- 3 The required TRA/TMZ will be activated by NOTAM no less than 24 hours prior to the planned flights.
- 4 Flights will take place **between 0700-1900 (0600-1800)**.
- 5 The UAS will operate from the Amazon Fulfilment Centre (MME1) near Darlington and participate in an airspace trial to the North and West of Teesside International Airport.
- 6 The TRA/TMZ can only be active when Teesside ATC are operational. The TRA/TMZ may be deactivated when Prime Air operations are not taking place to minimise the impact on other airspace users. Activation and deactivation will be coordinated with Teesside ATC.
- 7 BVLOS drone activity will take place only under Class D Visual Meteorological Conditions (VMC).
- 8 Any crewed aircraft wishing to transit or enter the TRA/TMZ must be equipped with ADS-B OUT and equipment must be active and serviceable (except in the case of an emergency), establish and maintain two-way radio communication with Teesside ATC, and obtain a specific clearance to cross or enter the TRA/TMZ.
- 9 Any crewed aircraft requiring entry to land in or depart from a site within the TRA/TMZ is required to provide as much notice as practicable and Teesside ATC will endeavour to provide approval as soon as possible. If departing from a site within the TRA/TMZ, approval can be sought from Teesside ATC via Radar on 118.855 or telephone on 01325-331020.

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The TRA/TMZ will be established to segregate the UAS activity as defined below:
